#### A Short Article from Pastor Luke

#### Happy Are You . . .

Despite the disappointments of life, Christians remain joyful through all of it. He does not turn a blind eye to reality, but faces it and remains joyful, knowing that whatever happens in life is far better than what he deserves in his sin. The Christian is aware of God's anger at sin, but also is constantly reflecting upon the work of Christ on the Cross, where His anger was placed on the innocent Jesus, instead of sinful man.

The Christian's understanding of suffering is closely tied to his understanding of the Cross, salvation and the future. I Peter 1:6 says, "In this you rejoice, though now for a little while, if necessary, you have been grieved by various trials . . . " The emphasis is that trials are short-lived. All suffering will come to an end when the Christian is ultimately brought to glory. After all, "to live is Christ, and to die is gain" (Philippians 1:21). The understanding is that you know that your life is not limited to your life as you know it now. You know that there is an eternity ahead of you, therefore, present trials are only trials . . . they are not permanent.

Since the Christian is aware of sin and the mercy of God through Christ Jesus, his attitude remains joyful through life. Deuteronomy 33:29 is a reminder of the joy of one saved by God, "Happy are you, O Israel! Who is like you, a people saved by the Lord, a shield of your help, and the sword of your triumph! Your enemies shall come fawning to you, and you shall tread upon their backs."

Dear Christian, may you be *happy* as you realize you are part of a people *saved* by the Lord. Remind yourself of the gospel each day. May the times of struggle and the times of laughter be opportunities for you to boast in the mercy of Christ Jesus.
